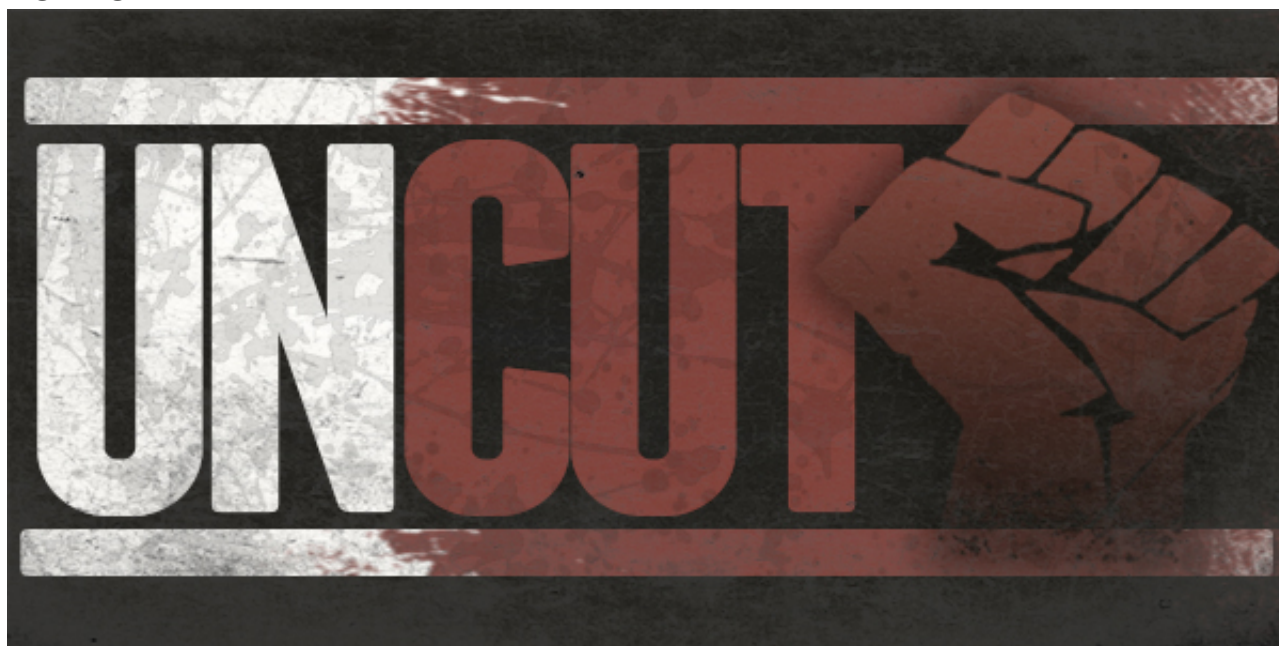


SHOW OPEN

GULF COAST CONNECTION vs. MIDAS MANCINI AND GETAWAY JONES

DDK:

Hot off the heels of a great edition of DEFtv, we're now in the thick of MAXDEF season! Many wrestlers have stepped up to try and cement a spot at DEFCON 2026! Others look to regroup! Tonight, we have great action for you! In our main event, we have Titanes Familia members Titaness and Brooklynn Rivera and they take on the team of No Fun Dean and Slightly Fun Jen!

Lance:

But first, we've got a tag team HOSS FITE as the team of The Gulf Coast Connection, Theodore Cain and Wingman Titus Campbell take on the team of Midas Mancini and Getaway Jones!

DDK:

Let's kick things over to Darren Quimbey up next for our introductions!

The camera focuses in on DEFIANCE's Hall of Fame-worthy ring announcer.

Darren Quimbey:

The following contest is scheduled for one fall! Introducing first...

Darren Quimbey:

Accompanied to the ring by The Crescent City Kid... Hailing from The Crescent City... weighing in at a combined weight of 517 pounds... "Wingman" Titus Campbell... Theodore Cain... **THE GULF! COAST! CONNECTION!**

One by one, the Gulf Coast Connection come out and they have their game faces on. Wingman Titus Campbell leads the trio with Theodore Cain and the masked Crescent City Kid right behind them, holding his hand out in a black protective cast! CCK and Theodore Cain hand out their signature Mardi Gras beads and masks to the masses before heading into the ring! Campbell poses for the people while Theodore Cain throws up the shaka sign!

Lance:

Welcome back to the Crescent City Kid! This is the first time we've seen him since that heinous attack carried out by Titanes Familia. Killjoy smashed his hand into steel steps, resulting in being out of action for the past eight weeks! Our understanding is he will be cleared imminently for competition!

DDK:

That's great news! He was missed backstage, that's for sure!

CCK remains outside with the GCC's precious prize bag as Cain and Campbell wait for their opponents.

The music plays and out comes a chiseled man with slicked-back brown hair, dressed in a gold-colored wifebeater, dress jeans and fancy shoes. Next to him, a brown bearded TANK of a man dressed in a black dress shirt and red tie with the sleeves cut off.

Darren Quimbey:

And their opponents... at a combined weight of 600 pounds... The team of **MIDAS MANCINI AND GETAWAY JONES!**

The men who may or may not have affiliations with a specific crime syndicate walk out and get mixed reactions from the fans, some liking and some hating it. Mancini looks pretty smug and Getaway Jones looks out to both sides of the arena before they make it to the ring. Mancini climbs up the steps and poses while Getaway Jones folds his arms and looks out to the audience menacingly.

Lance:

Big opportunity for Mancini and Jones to impress!

Once both men enter the ring, referee Hector Navarro calls for the bell. Midas Mancini and Theodore Cain both start for their teams.

DING DING

Cain and Mancini lock up in the middle of the ring with Mancini quickly switching things up for a go-behind into a hammerlock. He tries to keep The Smash Surfer at bay and then trips him up to a grounded hammerlock. Mancini continues to bring the smugness with a tight hammerlock as Cain is grounded. Campbell and CCK cheer on their buddy at ringside as Cain tries to fight back up. Despite Midas trying to keep him down, Cain fights up until Mancini uses a hair pull takedown to bring him back to the mat! He gets some jeers from the Canadian Faithful as he poses.

DDK:

Midas Mancini worked that arm well enough, but now he's stopping to gloat instead of following up.

He goes over to grab Cain again, but The Smash Surfer surprises him by grabbing the leg and taking him down with a big flapjack to the mat! The 246-pound Floridian then jumps on Mancini's back and starts pretending to use him as a surfboard!

DDK:

And that's what Mancini gets! Cain Making Waves... no, that's what he calls this taunt!

Cain jumps off Mancini's back and then picks him up by the waist before tagging in the big man of Gulf Coast Connection! The crowd cheers as Campbell and Cain both whip Mancini to the ropes and then take him down with double running shoulder blocks! The C&C Connection then high-five and then drop a double elbow drop into the chest of Mancini!

Lance:

There's some great double-team work by the Gulf Coast Connection tonight! They want bigger opportunities but need to string together some wins to do it!

Campbell looks out to the Canadian Faithful and gets some support as Mancini rests near the ropes and puts his hands up in a timeout. Campbell ain't buying it and boots him in the chest before making the tag back to Theodore Cain. Campbell grabs onto Mancini and then both men connect with a double hip toss out of the corner! The questionably-legal businessman gets slammed and right after that, Cain hits the ropes and nails a flipping senton!

DDK:

Flipping senton by The Smash Surfer! Here comes the cover!

ONE!

TWO!

NO!

Mancini kicks out, but Cain is on him. He hears the cheering Faithful and then waits on Mancini. He goes to grab the BRAZEN sensation, only to get a two-fingered eye poke out of desperation!

DDK:

That's a questionable tactic if I've ever see one. According to my notes, he calls that... ahem... The Goldfingers. Cute.

The Faithful jeer Mancini as he rolls over and tags Getaway Jones so he can make his own get-Away out of the ring! Jones slowly climbs through the ropes.

Lance:

And here comes the 341-pound Getaway Jones!

And as Cain is disposed of, he doesn't see Getaway Jones hit the ropes until it's too late, getting **FLATTENED** with a big shoulder tackle!

DDK:

The Smash Surfer just got **SMASHED** with that running shoulder tackle by Jones!

Jones hits the ropes again and showing fairly decent speed for a man that big, he stops and steps over Cain... **THEN** falls backwards all his weight into the chest!

Lance:

He faked out Cain with that falling senton!

DDK:

And now Mancini and Jones have the control! Nice work!

Jones is back up and then slowly picks Cain up as he's clutching his ribs. He picks him up and then holds Cain in a body slam position as he allows Mancini to make the tag. Jones slams Cain to the mat, allowing Mancini to run in, leap over Cain to get to the middle rope and then score with a big middle-rope moonsault! The Miami Faithful are impressed at the 250-pound moonsault and so is Midas, as he looks pretty happy with himself!

DDK:

Great agility by Mancini! Can they score the win?

ONE!

TWO!

NO!

The shoulder of Cain comes up and Mancini doesn't look pleased!

Lance:

I'm very impressed with how Midas Mancini and Getaway Jones have been working together. There's another tag by Getaway Jones!

Jones gets the tag and the bearded monster comes in. He puts all his weight on top of Cain near the ropes by stepping on him! He stands there until Hector Navarro warns him and gives him a five-count to break it up. Jones steps off of him and then pulls Cain just enough from the ropes to allow Mancini the chance to tag in again.

Lance:

Those are some quick tags by Jones and Mancini! Now where's he going?

DDK:

This could be the Golden Sky! A senton bomb off the top rope!

Mancini holds out his hand with the golden glove, then gives a thumbs down before looking for the top rope senton flip... but **MISSES** as Cain rolls out of the way! After crashing to the mat, he holds his back in pain and kicks his legs in agony against the mat! Campbell has a hand out ready to make the tag and The Faithful are ready for it!

DDK:

There was no water in the pool by Midas Mancini! And now that gives Cain the chance to get to Titus Campbell!

The Wingman waits for his tag and when Cain makes it over... HE GETS IT! The Faithful cheer as he waits for Midas to get up off the mat, only to take him down with a big clothesline! Midas gets knocked down, but tries to pick himself back up, only to catch a second clothesline by The Wingman!

Lance:

The Wingman living up to his name! 6'6" and 270 pounds flying all over the place!

Getaway Jones tries to get into the ring, only to catch a big boot by Theodore Cain that knocks him off the apron! Now his focus is back on Mancini. He tries to pick up the mobster(?) in a fireman's carry, only for Mancini to slip out in desperation and go for the roll-up!

ONE!

TWO!

NO!

Lance:

Midas ALMOST got him! But wait! Cain's back up! He's got Midas on his shoulders!

Campbell looks out to the crowd and SPINS around! Many times!

DDK:

Midas Mancini tried to steal one, but now he's stuck in some Turbulence from The Wingman!

The Faithful cheer as he finally inches near the ropes and then lets Cain tag in as he continues to spin him around! After the disorienting Airplane Spin, he drops a dizzy Mancini on his feet, allowing Cain to pick him up for his own fireman's carry... then DROPS him across the knee with a fireman carry jawbreaker!

DDK:

Great combo! The Turbulence followed right into High Tide! Cover by Cain!

Cain makes the cover with The Faithful counting along while Campbell blocks Getaway Jones from saving his associate!

ONE!

TWO!

THREE!

Darren Quimbey:

Here is your winner... THE GULF COAST CONNECTION!

After the music hits, referee Hector Navarro goes over to raise the arms of both Cain and Campbell! The Crescent City Kid joins in the ring to celebrate with his friends!

Lance:

That was a very impressive showing from Mancini and Getaway Jones, but The Gulf Coast Connection gets back on the winning track tonight!

DDK:

And it's great to see CCK back as well! Looking forward to his in-ring return!

Jones helps Mancini out of the ring and helps walk him out from ringside. Meanwhile, the never-ending Mardi Gras celebration continues from Campbell, Cain and CCK inside the ring for the Canadian Faithful!

SUPER MALAK ODYSSEY 8

The wind swirls, kicking up dust in the process. The sun beams down hot. Really hot. There's nothing but sand and muted colored dunes as far as the eye can see. Cacti and tumbleweeds are the only flora and fauna in this desert locale. There is one saving grace as a smallish one road town sits at the bottom of the valley. There's a bank, a horse track, train lines galore and of course, a shady saloon where the locals frequent for a good time. Malak Garland finds himself standing before the town.

Malak Garland:

This must be the Train Yards. I gotta find cOnOr fReiGhT for my quest now. Looks like my odyssey continues.

He notices his garb is something straight out of an old time western, frayed hat and all. His spurs clink as he walks into town. He notices a kerfuffle bursting out from the saloon so naturally, his curiosity causes him to rush over.

Malak Garland:

Garland stares at the floorboards for a moment.

Malak Garland:

Malak carries on, entering the dimly lit saloon. It's a scene in there and what a scene. Scantly clad femmes scoot around the show floor with drinks, food and other "toys" in hand as filthy train workers throw money around like it's going out of style. Garland quickly catches up with cOnOr fReiGhT, who is in the ear of the tall man they just had a squabble with.

Malak Garland:

Psssssssssst. Heyyyyyyyyy, cOnOr. Maybe it's not a good idea to talk to this guy again.

cOnOr backs Malak over to the nearest wall.

cOnOr fReiGhT:

Listen here and listen good, Mal! I hashed things out with Tall Man, so we're good, compendo? Besides, look, there's someone who I want you to meet but she's in the VIP section.

Once again, cOnOr disappears behind a curtain without notice, going deeper and deeper into the gullet of the saloon. Malak exchanges glances with Tall Man who just sort of shrugs his shoulders before turning his attention to a lady caller. It's clear he needs to follow cOnOr fReiGhT to the VIP section, where who knows what is waiting for him.

Christie Zane is on set for an interview here on Uncut!

Christie Zane:

After what was a major episode of DEFtv, we have big news coming up for the next edition live from Scotiabank Saddle Dome in Calgary, Alberta, Canada! Right now, I have one of the new champions that came out of DEFCON ... our new Favoured Saints champion! Lonnie Luck!!!

Doing a little fargo-esque strut into the frame, a very giddy Lonnie Luck has on a light grey plaid suit and sun glasses with the Favoured Saints title worn around his waist with the coat open to show it off.

Lonnie Luck:

Christie, thank you for the talk session.

Christie Zane:

Appreciate you being here. After what was another noteworthy episode of DEFtv, we heard you say that you would be defending your Favoured Saints championship and you wanted a major challenger.

Lonnie Luck:

That's right. I wanted to have this time because after watching everything that went down on DEFtv, I was allowed to put out an official challenge into the air. Christy, I don't want to just take on any opponent. I made my name this year by beating three men when I swept the Most Precious Gems at DEFIANCE Road. Lonnie Luck:

Christie's eyes nearly bulge out of their head at the news.

Christie Zane:

Lonnie Luck:

That's right. I'm going big, Christie! We both want something out of this! Malak wants a championship to make himself feel whole after terrorizing and whining his way on top for a whole ass year with the FIST. I want a chance to prove that I can take on the tippy top tier talent that's in DEFIANCE Wrestling and do what barely anyone else has been able to do in that time. Malak, I'm offering you a golden opportunity for at least one of us to walk out of Calgary with something we want! I talked about all the big things I've been able to do in 2025 and the Son of Sin City wants to try his last last name by beating you

Lonnie turns to Christie.

Lonnie Luck:

You can call me Head and Shoulders, Christie! If Malak accepts my challenge, I'm going to take care of that Flake!

TITANES FAMILIA vs. THE DASHER SIBS

Lance:

What a challenge laid out by Lonnie Luck there! We've seen Malak Garland seemingly in a tail spin since losing the FIST at DEFCON... but you can NEVER count Malak Garland out. He will always find a way so if he accepts, Lonnie Luck better be careful!

DDK:

It's now time for our main event! Titanes Familia's own mother figure, Titaness, and "La Angelita" Brooklynn Rivera take on a hot BRAZEN team, The Dasher Sibs, Tommy and Maggie Dasher! The Familia have grown out of control! Can they keep up their winning ways tonight or will the Dasher Sibs be a family problem for the Familia?

Lance:

Let's take it to Darren Quimbey with the introductions for our main event!

The camera pans to the very announcer!

Darren Quimbey:

The following tag team match is set for one fall and is your main event! Introducing first...

♪ "The Distance" by Cake ♪

The live feed returns to the arena, with music already playing over the PA.

Standing on the stage are a man and a woman, decked out in white jumpsuits smattered with Union Jacks and various automotive logos. The man is about 6'1", lean, with trim brown hair and full stubble. The woman is about 5'1" with very poofy blonde hair and a red lip for good measure.

Darren Quimbey:

Hailing from Silverstone, Northamptonshire, England, and fighting at a combined weight of three-hundred and fifty-seven pounds... please welcome to DEFIANCE TV, "BABY DRIVER" TOMMY and "MASTERMIND" MAGGIE DASHER! **THE DASHER SIBS!**

The camera cuts to the two making their way to the ring! Once they reach the ring, Tommy jumps over the ropes while Maggie does a leaping roll through the middle. They meet inside and pose for the crowd!

DDK:

We saw Midas Mancini and Getaway Jones earlier. In BRAZEN, they make up Oceans Four and have had an extended rivalry with the Nick Otto Trust, led by former BRAZEN Champion Nick "Lotto" Otto!

Lance:

We've seen the Dasher Sibs in action previously against Rain City Ronin back on DEFtv last year. Let's see what they can get away with against Titanes Familia's Titaness and Brooklynn Rivera!

♪ Father, father, unforgivable, This is my house, you made it personal
It's always trouble when they go too far! Nobody mess with my familia ♪

♪ "Familia" by Anuel AA and Nicky Minaj feat. Bantu ♪

Two gold spotlights shine on stage, left to right. On the left stands Titaness. Gold-tinted sunglasses, a golden hood, black top and pants with the "Familia" logo written down the leg. In the right spotlight, Brooklynn Rivera with a black mouthguard in her mouth. Wearing black tights with a gold line up the sides, a black and gold top with a Puerto Rican flag patch in the corner her hair tied in two long braids. They both dab fists with one another and then head towards the ring.

Darren Quimbey:

And their opponents, accompanied by “The Man of the House” Uriel Cortez... introducing The Mother of Suplexes... Breaker of Backs... Bringer of Big Boots... Baroness of Bombs... She is “THE PRETTY POWERFUL”... TITANESS! “LA ANGELITA” BROOKLYNN RIVERA! They are to be referred to as the only DEFy Award-Winning Familia in DEFIANCE History... **TITANES FAMILIA!**

Lance:

Still holding that Faction of the Year 2024 award over our heads, I see.

DDK:

They never stopped, to be fair.

Rivera follows Titaness up the steps. They both pose on the ring apron with Titaness hitting a double bicep while Rivera slashes a thumb across her throat, mean-mugging The Dasher Sibs. They both enter the squared circle and take their corners. Both teams decide who will start first with Maggie Dasher getting the chance while Brooklynn Rivera wants to take on the smaller half of the brother-sister duo.

Lance:

This one should be interesting!

DING DING

The size difference is already on display as the six-foot Brooklynn Rivera looks down at Maggie Dasher. To be a jerk, she goes to her knees and starts putting up her dukes, which earns her some jeering from the Vancouver Faithful. She waves her hands and tells Maggie to bring it. Maggie does so but when she charges at Rivera, she gets her arm snatched and then taken down to the canvas with an arm-based Judo throw! Rivera is back on her feet and jumps on the middle buckle to talk some more trash to The Faithful!

Lance:

Brooklynn Rivera is quickly earning a reputation as a loudmouth! And she’s not even hiding behind any other members of The Familia! That Judo and Muay Thai background make her so dangerous!

When Brooklyn turns around to jump off the buckles, Maggie Dasher is already right there and nails a running dropkick to the knee of Rivera! Rivera hobbles on her feet and then Maggie follows with a calf kick to the body of Rivera that sends her into the corner of The Dasher Sibs! The Vancouver Faithful show some love for the brother-sister duo as she makes the tag to Tommy Dasher!

DDK:

Rivera paid for her arrogance there! Let’s see what Tommy Dasher can do!

Tommy Dasher goes right to work on Rivera with a quick jab to the stomach followed by an uppercut, showing off his British strong style experience! He goes for a whip, but Rivera breaks it and doubles him over with a sole kick to the gut. She takes hold of the arm, but he’s quick to snag Rivera to the canvas with an arm bar of his own, throwing the former fighter off her game for the moment! Rivera lets out a few choice swear words before trying to pull herself to her feet, only to be greeted with a quick elbow and an uppercut to the joint of her elbow!

Lance:

The Dasher Sibs are showing something against La Familia tonight! They’ve got Brooklynn Rivera off-kilter!

Tommy Dasher grabs the same arm and twists it with an arm wringer. He holds La Angelita’s arm out and makes a quick tag to Maggie Dasher who climbs the second rope. She flies off with a double stomp to the exposed left arm of Rivera, who holds the limb in pain!

DDK:

Great work by the brother and sister tandem! I honestly didn’t know what to expect, but they’re showing out tonight against former BRAZEN Tag Team Champions!

Titaness tries to give Brooklynn a pep talk.

Titaness:

Damn it! Don't let these smalls show you up! You're Titanes Familia! Act like it!

Maggie Dasher follows up on the arm work and grabs the arm of Brooklynn before hitting a double knee armbreaker! Rivera falls to her knees and still clutches at her arm. Maggie Dasher has her right where she wants her and runs the ropes... but Titaness quickly puts a foot down on the middle rope, sending the younger Dasher Sib spilling through the ropes first!

BOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOO!

DDK:

The BRAZEN Referee never saw that interference from Titaness!

In fact, The Pretty Powerful is feigning innocence and is checking her nails after Maggie's nasty spill to the floor. She reaches over and gets a tag from Brooklynn Rivera, allowing Titaness to casually walk down to the floor. Also a full foot taller than Maggie Dasher, she grabs her in an electric chair just as she tries to stand! She holds her there and then DRIVES her face-first into the ring apron! Inside the ring, Brooklynn is howling at the state of Maggie Dasher and her second crash and burn moment!

Lance:

And just like that, La Familia have taken control!

The Pretty Powerful Titaness once again takes hold of Maggie Dasher, this time with a full military press! She holds her and then chucks her back inside through the bottom and middle rope. When she climbs in, Titaness goes for a rather lax cover with just a forearm over Dasher's face.

ONE!

TWO!

NO!

It's an easy kickout, but Titaness doesn't look that dismayed.

DDK:

I think with a more secure cover, Maggie may or may not have been able to kick out. It's clear Titaness doesn't want that!

The ladies of Titanes Familia continue their punishment. A tag goes to Brooklynn Rivera. After taking a moment to try and shake feeling back into her left arm, she grabs Maggie Dasher and holds her in the ropes with a knee to the back to choke her out. After a few moments, she starts swinging at Maggie with a number of nasty crossface punches while she's in the ropes, forcing Tommy Dasher to be able to do nothing but watch peril befall his sister.

DDK:

And there's Maggie Dasher getting worked over by The Familia right now with those crossface punches! Her style is very raw and that's what makes Brooklynn Rivera dangerous. There's nothing pretty about how she works in that ring.

Rivera picks up Maggie Dasher and then makes a tag to Titaness. Rivera rolls Maggie through with a big snapmare followed by a stiff soccer kick to the back, followed immediately by a MASSIVE Lady Lariat from Titaness!

DDK:

Now THAT was a deadly combination! The soccer kick leading to the Lady Lariat! Can Titaness get the win?

She covers Maggie Dasher.

ONE!

TWO!

SAVED BY TOMMY DASHER!

Lance:

No, there's Tommy Dasher coming to the aid of his sister! She's been brutalized in the past few minutes!

Tommy returns to his corner, but gives his sister some words of encouragement beforehand! Titaness tells him to shut up and get back to his corner before he grabs Maggie and puts her over the shoulder. She sets up Maggie for a running powerslam... but gets countered into a big tornado DDT first!

DDK:

No! Maggie Dasher pulls that great tornado DDT counter out of nowhere! Can she get to her brother?!

The Vancouver Faithful cheer on Maggie Dasher as she crawls to the corner. Titaness holds the back of her head in pain and crawls over to tag Brooklynn Rivera. She gets into the ring, but so does Tommy Dasher!

Lance:

Tommy jumps into action! He allegedly has plenty of practice leaping in and out of vehicles!
